Purpose Driven and PEACE Skills Training Thursday, June 23, 7:00 pm (Pastors &Team) Friday, June 24, 8 a.m. - 5 pm Saturday, June 25, 8 a.m. - 4 pm

With the Purpose Driven P.E.A.C.E. Plan, it is the Church's mission to mobilize ordinary people, empowered by God, to make a difference together wherever they are. The ministry goal is to inspire, equip, and train your members to effectively share and train Purpose Driven concepts. The upcoming skills training is your opportunity to learn specific, practical skills that will enable you to serve cross-culturally. No previous experience is necessary and there is no cost to the training.

LITERACY AND ESL

Learn to equip/train churches to become ESL & literacy learning centers for children & adults. **POVERTY SAVINGS**

Jesus loves the poor, and so does the PEACE Plan's Poverty Initiative. If you want to help the poor, this will be a very practical program that will set you on the path of serving the poor wherever God takes you.

CLEAN WATER EDUCATION AND TECH

Water is life. Lack of clean water and sanitation limits life for over 783 million people in the developing world. Women and children haul water long distances. The water is usually contaminated. Without access to clean water, people cannot work productively or attend school regularly. Millions die from water borne diseases each year. Children under age five are especially vulnerable to disease and death.

HIV/AIDS AND HEALTHCARE

Come and learn how to respond to health issues by focusing on primary and preventative health care, telemedicine and advancing the skill sets of healthcare professionals. Also learn the basics of equipping the church to care for people living with HIV and AIDS; and training local churches in prevention, care, treatment, and support.

ORPHAN CARE

Come learn God's heart for the orphan and simple things everyone can do for the orphaned and vulnerable children in their community and around the world.

PEACE CHURCH TRAINING

Are you interested in learning more about becoming a PEACE Leader at your church or training PEACE Leaders at other churches as part of the church training initiative? We will be learning about the first two steps of the PEACE Plan (Foundation and Mobilization) and what it means for a church to have the Purpose Driven, PEACE Plan, UUPGs, and "every member on mission" modeled in their church.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING LOCAL AND GLOBAL

Learn how to train churches to care for victims of child abuse, sexual abuse, human trafficking and slavery.

CHURCH PLANTING OVERSEAS WITH UNCHURCHED PEOPLE GROUPS

Learn how to start small; Bible follow-up listening groups for non-readers and readers alike. Learn also about "Bible Storying," as a means to evangelize and start small groups, and eventually establish churches from those groups. These are tools that your PEACE team can use, together with your host church members, to plant a church.

PEACE TRAINING LIST CONTINUED...

PURPOSE DRIVEN AND SENIOR PASTORS (SENIOR PASTORS ONLY)

This skills training covers the introduction of Purpose Driven Journey, Discipleship Track Process, and Purpose Driven Church concepts while on mission in order to lay the foundation for PEACE. The module reviews the basic Purpose Driven vision talks and touches on SHAPE (implementing volunteers in your church), implementing small groups, developing the culture of every member is a minister, developing membership and illustrations of models for injecting Purpose Driven in conversation.

CHURCH MANAGER - VOLUNTEER EXECUTIVE PASTORS (Friday only)

This training is designed for volunteer executive pastors, staff executive pastors, or senior pastors who are considering the development of a church manager. Come and see how to lead, execute, and manage the vision of the church.

WEEKEND COORDINATOR

This training will focus on teaching your weekend service coordinator to accomplish the churches mission by overseeing, executing, and planning the elements of weekend services and special event services.

CONNECT CLASS - (MEMBERSHIP CLASS 101)

This class is designed to clearly explain who and what your church is. You'll learn to teach about beliefs on salvation, statements of purpose, and your church's strategy and structure.

GROW CLASS (MATURITY CLASS 201)

Do you want to become more like Jesus? This class is designed to help your members develop the habits they need to jump-start and greatly enhance their spiritual growth. It will give them an in-depth guide to the spiritual habits every Christian needs in order to grow.

SERVE CLASS (MINISTRY CLASS 301)

Did you know that God created you with special gifts intended for his purposes? God didn't design ministry for just a few – he made each one of us a minister. At Class 301, your members learn how God can use their Spiritual Gifts, Hearts, Abilities, Personality, and Experiences (S.H.A.P.E.) to minister to the needs of others.

GLOBAL TRIP LEADERSHIP (Saturday only)

Successful PEACE trips are executed by effective leaders. The goal of this training is to give all PEACE leaders the necessary tools and information that they need to be effective.



A Little History

We moved into this facility 11 years ago from Olympia High School. We had an arrangement with the original owners to leaseto-own. For over a decade now we have treated the facility as if it was our own. We have had 24/7 access to it, and made improvements to it at our own expense. There was a change in ownership hands and we have been uncertain about our original plan. This week an agreement was made to allow CVCC to purchase the facility (10 K Sq/Ft) and land (3.35 Acres) for \$650,000. It is valued much higher than that (Over \$1M). We consider this to be a blessing and a huge answer to our prayers. We would like to immediately raise funds and we are assessing our financial options at this point.

Mission Support

The current owners have designated a Mission with which they are affiliated; "The Barnabas Project", as recipients for the sum of money we pay. This group focuses on helping independent missionaries in several countries.
