





God's Provision

We moved into this facility 11 years ago from Olympia High School. We had an arrangement with the original owners to lease-to-own. For over a decade now we have treated the facility as if it was our own. We have had 24/7 access to it, and made improvements to it at our own expense. There was a change in ownership and we have been uncertain about our original plan. This summer an agreement was made to allow CVCC to purchase the facility (10 K Sq/Ft) and land (3.35 Acres) for \$650,000. It is valued much higher than that (Over \$1M). We consider this to be a blessing and a huge answer to our prayers.

More Signs of Favor

The leadership began to immediately raise funds and assessed our financial

Several CVCC individuals or families have contributed to this purchase in the past few months. Some with a few hundred dollars and several with a thousand

2.) In addition to that the owners met with the CVCC leaders and offered to drop the price to \$550,000!

The elders and other leaders are seeing those 2 factors as signs of God leading us to pursue the remainder of the funds and secure the property in CVCC's name by the end of the year. In essence this gift of equity amounts to the single largest donation in the history of this church.

Funding Available

The Elders reached out to several funding institutions and lending organizations and have prioritized a relationship with **Church Development Fund** based in California. They specialize in helping churches in our situation. They are preparing to help us with a loan at a favorable interest rate. Our plan is to borrow the funds (\$500K) now and seek the Lord's provision for the purchase as we reduce this debt as soon as possible.

Mission Support Reminder

100% of the proceeds from this transaction are designated for "The Barnabas Group" which is an organization that supports independent missionaries in their cross-cultural gospel work. This is an exciting "Win-Win-Win" for the kingdom. Win #1 — CVCC gets the deed to the property, as well as a huge equity gift. Win #2 — \$550K goes to Missions Support

Win #3 — The Owner group can dissolve and/or blend into CVCC
