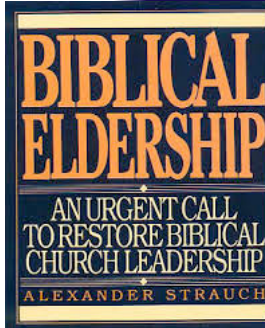

An ordained minister, Bill brings a wealth of valuable insight in the areas of emotional and behavioral problems among young people and is a certified trainer for "Therapeutic Crisis Intervention." His communication gifts combined with his life experience and honed insight put him in very high demand in this country and around the world as a speaker. 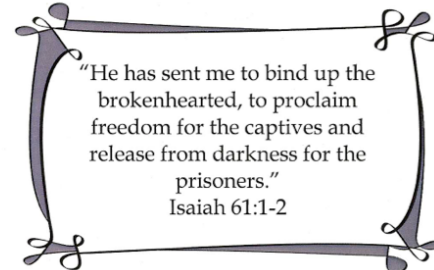

# Missions In October



"He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners."  
Isaiah 61:1-2

We are going to be joined by 2 of God's excellent leaders in Ministry during the month of October. Their primary focus will be to inform and inspire CVCC in the arena of World Missions. They are hoping to build our awareness and solicit our prayer and support. The Family of God is so blessed to have servants like Keith & Stephanie reaching out in the name of Jesus. Join in and be encouraged by what the Lord is doing in other places.

## Sunday October 13<sup>th</sup>

- 1.) 9:00 AM Meet In Classroom Setting. Keith Wilkins is Director of Development for *Kontakmission USA*, a church planting ministry working mostly in Europe, the least Christian continent in the world where only about 2.5% of the people are Bible-believing Christians. Kontakmission started in the late 70's with Germans and Swiss going into Austria to evangelize. They have now planted hundreds of growing churches in 33 countries with 230 missionaries on the field. The American arm of KM was started in 2000 by Rob and Carla Harris. The mission is transnational in leadership, using church planting teams with workers from several countries including the host nation. Keith graduated from Ozark Bible College where he met and married Sonya Williams and they have four children. He has served churches in Illinois and Missouri including eleven years at College Heights Christian Church in Joplin.



## Tuesday October 15<sup>th</sup>

Stephanie Freed and her father, Joe Garman, co-founded *Rapha (healing) House* in 2003 after Joe saw a girl rescued after she was sold into slavery by her parents. Such rescue efforts were initially the vision of Cambodian leaders who saw girls disappear from villages and sold and exploited. They saw the need to help but lacked the structure and resources. While at *Rapha House* girls rescued from such situations are cared for and taught about Christ and His love while receiving vocational training and counseling. Stephanie is the Director of the mission and lives in Joplin, Missouri, with her husband, Brandon, and three children. The mandate for *Rapha House* is from Proverbs: "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves; ensure justice for those being crushed; yes speak up for the poor and helpless and see that they get justice." 31:8-9, NLT

- 6.) We Value Innovation & Creativity! Because it takes all we are to succeed!

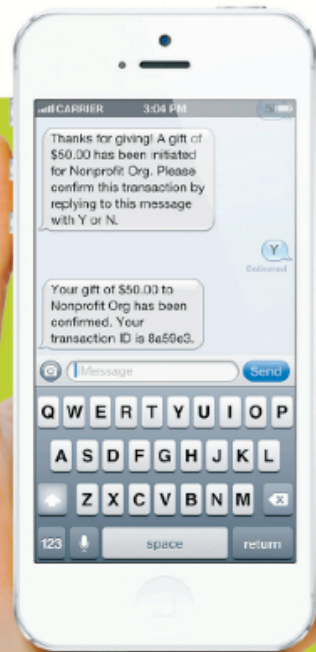
