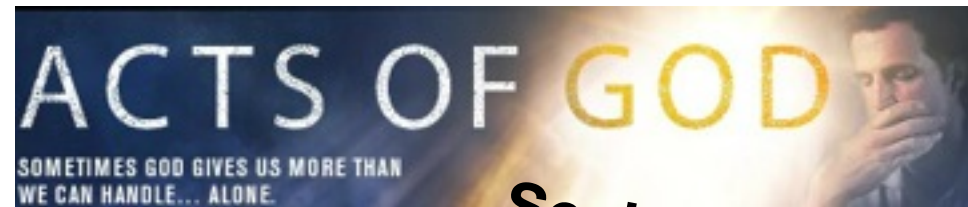

advance Gods Kingdom in the Buvuma islands of Lake Victoria through transforming communities and empowering indigenous leaders to minister effectively among their own people. Bob served God in the pulpit in Oregon for many years and now works with SHIMs **Discipleship and Evangelism Ministries** as well as **Family Ministries**. He is currently developing a pastoral training curriculum, one not based on textbooks; rather, one which reaches the pastors through biblical storying orally with life application. Michelle's primary responsibility is in homeschooling their children. For SHIM, her current focus is sharing her home as opportunity arises, although she often joins Bob in teaching on marriage and parenting with the Family Ministry Team. The family also visits the SHIM base on Lingira Island and shares Jesus with the local village children.
