A Little History

We moved into this facility 11 years ago from Olympia High School. We had an arrangement with the original owners to lease-to-own. For over a decade now we have treated the facility as if it was our own. We have had 24/7 access to it, and made improvements to it at our own expense. There was a change in ownership hands and we have been uncertain about our original plan. This week an agreement was made to allow CVCC to purchase the facility (10 K Sq/Ft) and land (3.35 Acres) for **\$650,000**. It is valued much higher than that (Over \$1M). We consider this to be a blessing and a huge answer to our prayers. We would like to immediately raise funds and we are assessing our financial options at this point.

Mission Support

The current owners have designated a Mission with which they are affiliated; "The Barnabas Project", as recipients for the sum of money we pay. This group focuses on helping independent missionaries in several countries.
