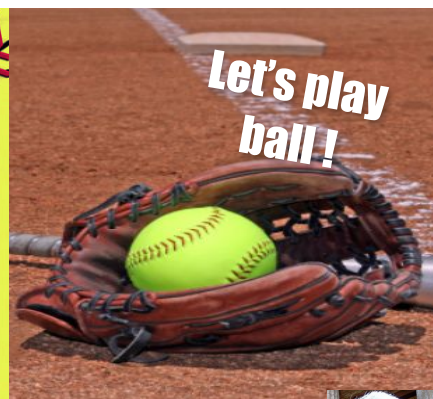

We have a lunch-time explanation of our discipleship process and how you can become part of the team of growing believers here at CVCC.



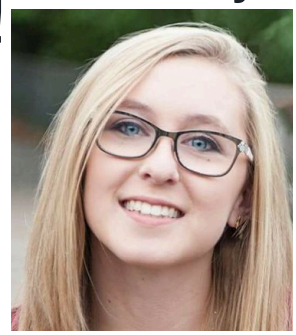
